



Research Project: DigiNet Inklusion

Network analyses and digital infrastructure development for regional support structures in the area of inclusion for child daycare facilities in Saxony



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As part of the “DigiNet Inklusion” project, an online survey of child daycare facilities in Saxony will be implemented in 2024 to analyze regional cooperation structures and the quality of cooperation in the area of inclusion. The focus will be on the quality of inclusive or integrative care and the integration of child daycare facilities into local support networks. The study aims to investigate interactions regarding the availability of support systems and educational opportunities (attitudes of daycare teams, willingness to accept children, skills in the daycare team) for children with disabilities and children with a migration background. In addition to being used for the research questions, the results are to be made usable for control processes through content and graphic processing.

With the help of a design-based research approach and in cooperation with local stakeholders (daycare centers, support systems, parents), a digital service for child daycare centers (web application) will be developed that can be used throughout Saxony, providing a simple overview of regional counseling services and enabling daycare centers and parents to contact support partners at a low threshold.
